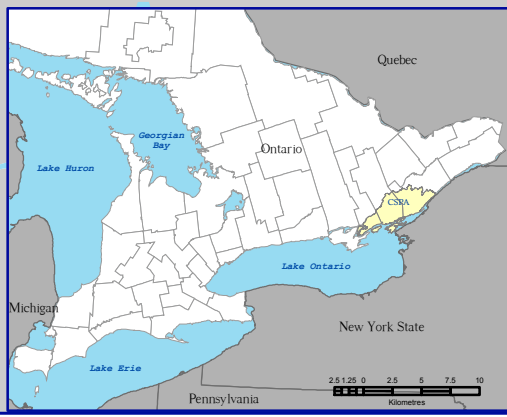
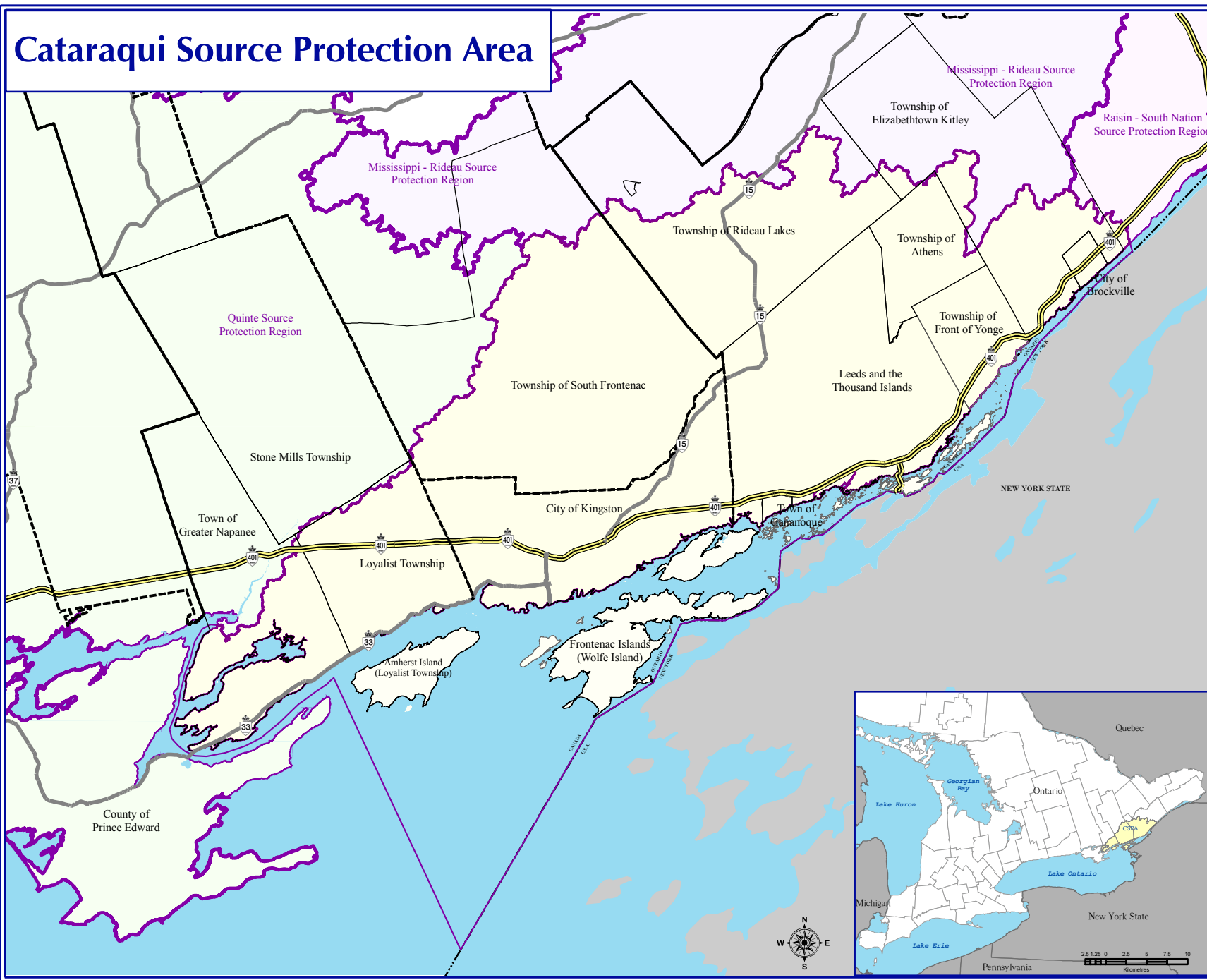


# Cataraqui Source Protection Area
